Nazareth Overseas Veteran Attending Transition School

Lieut. Stanley C. Hummel, son of Mr. and Mrs. Luther S. Hummel, 45 Belvidere Street, Nazareth, is now attending the fighter transition school at the Fourth Operational Training Unit of the Air Transport Command's Ferrying Division at Greenwood, Miss. This is the only school of its kind in the United States, and Lieut. Hummel will learn to fly four of the fastest fighter planes in the air. Upon successful completion of the rugged 30-day course, he will return to his home station to ferry such planes as the P-47, P-63 and P-51 to all parts of the country.

Lieut. Hummel, recently returned from the C-B-I Theater, completed 70 trips over the Hump. He was awarded the DFC and Air Medal with Oak Leaf Clusters, the American, European and Asiatic Theater ribbons. Before entering the service in 1940 he was a student at Kansas State University.
