

AWARDED PURPLE HEART

**Pvt. Donald Kemmerer, Nazareth,
Honored in Pacific Area.**

A Nazareth youth was among officers and men of the U. S. Air Corps honored for action in the southwest Pacific.

He is Pvt. Donald Y. Kemmerer, 211 South New Street, Nazareth, who received the award of the Purple Heart for wounds received in action near Port Moresby, New Guinea on August 17, 1942.

The award, including six silver stars and 23 Purple Hearts, were reported last night by Lieut. Gen. George C. Kenney, commander of the Allied air forces in the southwest Pacific area.
