There were plenty of Japs in the hills, though, and the Yanks had no trouble accumulating souvenirs. Left to right are Corporal Harry Donovan, 804½ Union Street, Allentown, a former Lehigh Portland Cement Company employe, and Private Joseph Kramer, 640 Atlantic Street, Bethlehem, former proprietor of Kramer's Cafe in this city. Their outfit flies "Sky Train" transports, bringing supplies and equipment from rear bases to the "Fightin' 13th's" frontline airstrips, from which the veteran jungle air force launches its strikes at Borneo, the Dutch Indies and the Philippines.
