### Sgt. Goth on Aerial Sightseeing Tour Over Battlefields

AN EIGHTH AIR FORCE FIGHTER STATION, England—First Sgt. Edward A. Goth, 31, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward E. Goth, 623 Fourth Avenue, Bethlehem, Pa., recently

participated in an aerial sightseeing tour over European battlefields.

Sgt. Goth is first sergeant of an ordnance company attached to the Fourth Fighter Group, commanded by Col. Everett W. Stewart of Abilene, Kan., and has been part of its non-flying personnel for 35 months.

While flying at 1,000 feet over Germany in a four-engine Libera-

tor bomber, he was able to view the grand scale destruction below of railroad yards, bridges and factories. It was a six and a half hour flight,

beginning and ending at the Fourth Group's base in Essex County, England.
