Home on a 30-day furlough after participating in operations off Casablanca, Robert Scheetz, son of Mrs. Eastburn Scheetz, 229 Raspberry Street, has declined to relate any part played in the huge troop operation last month.

Scheetz, who enlisted in the U. S. Navy and had been attached to the U. S. Transport Tasker H. Bliss, which was torpedoed and sunk during the operations, was a former Bethlehem Steel Company employe.
