Two Area Navy Men Free of Jap Prisons

John Shambora, radioman 1-c., 1127 Russell Avenue, and Nicholas R. Kalynych, machinist's mate 1-c., Easton Road, Hellertown, prisoners of the Japanese for many months, are returning to the States aboard the USS Ozark with 1,012 others liberated from prison camps in Japan. They are veterans of Corregidor, Wake and Guam.

Aboard the ship are 35 officers and 592 enlisted men of all United States fighting services, 247 Canadians and 138 civilians.

Shambora and Kalynych came aboard at Tokyo and after preliminary care, were taken to Guam for thorough medical examinations and clothing for the journey home.
