J. G. Meyer, Jr. Dies On French Battlefield

The first war casualty from Miller Heights was reported when Mrs. Joseph G. Meyer, Jr., received a telegram from the War Department informing her of her husband's death in France, November 12.

Pfc. Meyer was attached to a medical detachment with the 359th Infantry and was overseas since July. He entered the Army in May of 1941, and served at many bases in this country prior to going overseas.

He is survived by his wife, the former Magdalena E. Garbush; an eight and a half months old daughter Carol Ann, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph G. Meyer, Sr., and a brother, John, with the United States Army overseas.

Prior to entering the Army Pfc. Meyer was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
