Fountain Hill Army Nurse Sent From Iceland to English Base

Mr. and Mrs. John Roman, of Gauff's Hill, are in receipt of a letter from their daughter, Second Lieutenant Eleanor E. Roman, R.N., who has been transferred from Iceland to England.

Lieutenant Roman, a graduate of Allentown Hospital, Nurses' College, 1940, enlisted in the American Nursing Corps as the first graduate nurse of the Allentown institution to enter World War II.

She left September 3, 1941 for Iceland where she has been serving Uncle Sam ever since and up to recent date when she was sent to England, arriving in London on August 10. She has not been home since she went to Iceland, but she kept her parents informed from time to time of her work and surroundings.

The last letter was written August 14, after she had arrived in England which her parents received on August 24.

Lieutenant Roman is also a graduate of Liberty High School, after which she entered the Allentown Hospital.

She is a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church and a granddaughter of Mrs. Max Thiel, of Delaware Avenue.
