## Killed in Action

## Pvt. Wagner, Bangor, is War Victim

Word has been received by Mrs. Hattie Wagner, 649 North Main Street, Bangor, that her son, Pvt. John Pershing Wagner, of the United States Army, has been killed in action.

The War Department information indicated Pvt. Wagner was killed in the Italian invasion on November 9, 1943.

He entered the service on March 26, 1942, and received his basic training at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He went overseas in June, 1943, and saw action in North Africa, Sicily and Italy.

He attended Bangor High School and prior to entering the service was employed in Easton.

Besides his mother he is survived by one brother, Pfc. Stanley Wagner, of the United States Army, stationed on the Alcan Highway.
