Mrs. Winnie Chegezy, Bethlehem R. D. 1, received word from the War Department that her son, Pvt. Joseph Chegezy, was killed in action in France. Pvt. Chegezy was inducted December 8, 1942, and received training at Camp McCoy, Wis., before being shipped to England, North Ireland and finally, France. Before being inducted he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

Surviving Pvt. Chegezy are his mother, three sisters, Mrs. William Blale, Mrs. Chester Repsher and Julia Chegezy; and a brother, Pfc. Stephen Chegezy, in Italy. Stephen is with the Coast Artillery and has been in the major campaigns in North Africa and Italy. He celebrated his second year in the U. S. Army yesterday.
