Pfc. William G. Kilpatrick was wounded in France, according to word received by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Kilpatrick of 337 South New Street. The message stated he has been removed to a U. S. Army Hospital in England and is slightly improved.

Kilpatrick enlisted in the U. S. Infantry on March 27, 1943, and has served overseas since September 23, 1943. Two brothers entered the service at the same time. They are Chief Petty Officer Joseph Kilpatrick, Jr., of the U. S. Navy and Robert Kilpatrick of the Army Air Forces.
