Cadet Carl Fuenfstueck, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Fuenfstueck, 536 Broadway, Bethlehem, has entered the Nashville Army Air Center.

At the center Cadet Fuenfstueck will take physical and psychological examinations to determine for which branch of aircrew service, bombing, navigating or piloting, he is best fitted. Physical training, academic study, and military drill are also part of cadet training at the Center. This is the first stop in a training program that will eventually graduate Cadet Fuenfstueck as a commissioned officer, with wings, in the Army Air Forces.
