## Bangor Soldier Dies In Action, SEP 2 9 1944 Parents Hear

Pyt. Melvin Ott, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Melvin Ott, North Main Street, Bangor, has been killed in action according to word received by his parents at noon today from the War Department.

The young soldier, aged about 23, died in action September 1, the telegram said, placing the fatal action in France. He entered service in October, 1942, and was sent overseas in February, 1944. He trained at Camp Atterbury, South Carolina.

He is survived by his parents and the following brothers and sister, Charles, Thomas, Russell, Horace, Ralph and June, all at home.
