Pvt. Edward A. Tarnowski, brother of Mrs. Joseph Rezzo, 2022 Davis Street, was wounded in action in France on an undisclosed date, according to a letter received from a hospital in England.

Pvt. Tarnowski entered the Army, March 24, 1943, and spent several months in a Louisville, Ky., hospital for knee injuries received in training while stationed at Fort Knox. Attached to the Armored Division, he went overseas in April. Before entering the service he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Co.

A brother, Seaman 2-c Adam Tarnowski Jr., recently completed boot training at Bainbridge, Md., Naval Training Center.
