**PROMOTED TO CAPTAIN.**

Promotion of First Lieutenant Bradford K. Smith, Coast Artillery Corps (AA), to the rank of captain, was announced yesterday by Major General James L. Collins, commanding general of the Puerto Rican Military Department.

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Royal E. Smith, of 31 Beech Street, East Orange, N. J. Captain Smith was born at Oak Bluffs, Mass., on October 28, 1913. He attended Lehigh University for four years, obtaining in 1935 a B.A. degree, majoring in chemistry.

He was commissioned second lieutenant in the Coast Artillery Corps Reserve on June 1, 1935, and was promoted to first lieutenant on July 1, 1939.
