Suffers Wound**

Mr. and Mrs. Frank Lard, Nazareth, Route 1, were informed by the War Department that their son, Cpl. Chester Lahr, who is with the Third Army, has been wounded in action in Germany. Cpl. Lahr has been overseas 13 months and was awarded the Oak Leaf Cluster for meritorious service in action.

The Lahr's have another son and daughter in the service; Sgt. Robert Lahr, in the Philippines, and Isabella Lahr, Y2c., stationed in Virginia.

May 8, 1945
