## Report Local Youth Killed Germany

Private First Class Charles B. Roach, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Suto Roach, 631 Terrace Avenue, is reported killed in action in Germany on November 15, according to a War Department telegram received by his parents last evening.

The 19-year-old youth was inducted November 23, 1943, and received his basic infantry training at Camp Croft, S. C., and Camp Meade, Md., before shipping overseas to England in May, 1944. Since then, he had seen action with the American First Army in Paris, France; Luxemburg and Aachen.

Prior to his induction, Pfc. Roach attended Liberty High School and was employed in the P. B. N. E. Railroad shop. He was a member of Christ Evangelical and Reformed Church.
