

Lobaugh, Donald R.

**Soldier Hero Wins  
Posthumous Award** APR 25 1945

WASHINGTON, (AP)—Pvt. Donald R. Lobaugh, 20, infantryman of Freeport, Pa., who died in a one-man attack on a strong Japanese position, was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor, the War Department announced.

Lobaugh was killed last July 22 at Afua, New Guinea, after he had blasted a road to safety for his isolated platoon.

April 25, 1945
