Cpl. Dan Curatola was re-cently promoted to his present grade in a little French town. Marienlle, 30 miles northeast of Verdon and 15 miles from Metz. He is stationed here with a repair unit using German Drisoners of war. Cpl. Curatola, who is ex-pected home soon with a dis-charge, was sent overseas to England in August, 1942. He found himself going to North Africa on his birthday, Octo-ber 26, 1942, and on to the Al-giers and Sicily invasions. On his following birthday, the young soldier again found him-self aboard ship heading for the invasion of France. Re-calling the day he hit the beach on June 6, Curatola, calls ever been to. He was wounded June 8 and evacuated June 10. Three of his brothers are also in the service, Pvt. Paul, with the A. A. F. at Amarillo, Texas; Pvt. Anthony, also with the A. A. F. at Buckley Field, Colo., and Pfc. Bruno, serving in the Mariannas at present. Cpl. Dan Curatola, holds the Bronze Star and Presidential Citation.
