## Wounded

Mr. and Mrs. Otis W. Gass, 619 Diehl Avenue, Fountain Hill, were informed in a War Department telegram received Sunday that their son, Cpl. Harold G. Gass, was wounded in action in Germany, November 13.

With an Engineer Combat Branch, Cpl. Gass has seen action in most of the major engagements from the Coast of Normandy to Germany and was one of the first Americans to enter Paris.

In the Army 6½ years, he has been overseas since January, 1944. Mr. and Mrs. Gass have three sons, a son-in-law and a grandson in the service.
