Wounded In Action

Mr. and Mrs. John Mikitka, 130 Minsi Trail Street, received a War Department telegram Saturday evening informing them that their son, Sgt. Peter Mikitka, had been slightly wounded in action in France, December 13, and had been awarded the Purple Heart. Sgt. Mikitka was inducted February 3, 1942, received his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and left for overseas duty in April, 1943. He participated in the North African campaign and in the invasions of Sicily, Italy and Southern France. He is recuperating in an Army Hospital somewhere in France at present. A brother, Pfc. Joseph Mikitka, is also serving with the U S. Third Army somewhere in France.
