

Army Medical Officer Made Lieut. Colonel

Word of the promotion of Major C. Earl Albrecht, Md., medical officer with the U. S. Army "somewhere in Alaska" to the rank of lieutenant colonel, has been received by Col. Albrecht's mother, Mrs. Elizabeth Albrecht, 53 West Church Street, Bethlehem. Col. Albrecht is the son of Mrs. Albrecht and the late Rev. C. A. Albrecht, Moravian minister. The young medical officer graduated at Moravian College for Men

in 1926, from the Theological Seminary in 1928 and from Jefferson Medical College in 1932. He and

his wife and young daughter, Elizabeth Jane, have resided at Palmer, Alaska, since 1935.

Col. Albrecht entered the Army a short time before Pearl Harbor, Dec. 7, 1941, as a captain, having been a Reserve officer.

Besides his mother he has a brother, Charles C. Albrecht, living at Riegelsville R. D. 1, and a sister, Mrs. Boyd Taufer, Eighth Avenue, Bethlehem.
