**Local Soldier
Wounded In
Italy October 13**

Pvt. William Zatovich, son of Mrs. Mary Zatovich, River Road, near Gauff's Hill, was seriously wounded in action in Italy October 13, according to a telegram received by the mother from the War Department earlier in the week. The message did not state the nature of the wounds nor in what action he received them.

Private Zatovich, who was graduated from the Allentown High School, entered the service of the armed forces last year, after being employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company as a machinist.

He received his basic training at Camp George Meade, Md., after which he was sent overseas to North Africa, where he took part in several major engagements in North Africa, Sicily and Italy. He is 22 years of age.
