SIXTH PORT HEADQUARTERS,
Southern France—Master Sergeant
O. Wagner, Bethlehem, Pa., was
awarded a certificate of commenda-
tion for outstanding services during
the arduous periods of reconstruc-
tion and operation at ports of Naples
and Marseilles. The award was
made April 22, by Col. Robert H.
Clarkson, port commandant on the
third anniversary of the activation
of Sixth Port Headquarters.

Sgt. Wagner is the son of Mr. and
Mrs. George P. Wagner, 219 West
Goepf Street, Bethlehem. He was
inducted into the Army on June 25,
1942, and came overseas in Novem-
ber 1942.

In addition to the certificate of

for participation in the Naples-Fog-
gia, Rome-Arno and southern
France campaigns and insignia de-
