**Marine Corporal
Home After Long
Service In Pacific**

Tommy Malone, Wydnor R. D. 3, a corporal in the U. S. Marines, is home on a 30-day leave after serving 25 months in the Pacific war theater. He is a son of Tom Malone, police officer at Lehigh University and a graduate of Bethlehem High, class of 1941.

Tommy returns home with four battle stars, a Presidential citation and a Commando graduation certificate that was signed by Col. Buckley, also of Bethlehem, who at the time was Malone's commander at Guadalcanal. Besides Guadalcanal he saw fighting service at Bougainville and two other islands invaded and captured by the Americans.
