Selected to become a yeoman in the WAVES, Shirley H. Phillips, 20, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. M. Phillips, 704 Cherokee Street, Bethlehem, has been enrolled in the U. S. Naval Training School for the Women's Reserve at Iowa State Teachers College, Cedar Falls, Ia.

She will take a course in shorthand, typing, Naval correspondence, records and forms and current events. When she has attained the Navy standards for the petty officer rating of yeoman, third class, she will be graduated with that standing and assigned to duty at a shore station within the United States to relieve an enlisted man for service afloat.

The Bluejacket has already undergone a period of "boot training" during which she was indoctrinated into the customs and procedures of the Navy.
