Spinal meningitis—plague hitting many sections of the country—added another person to its long list of fatalities when Pvt. Frank Fay (above), 20, died last night at 8:06 o'clock in Easton Hospital.

Pvt. Fay, inducted into Army service four weeks ago, was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth F. Fay, 839 Grant Street, Easton. He was admitted to the hospital Sunday morning. Following examination by a camp physician at New Cumberland, Pa., on Saturday, according to his family, the Easton boy was granted a sick leave. He and an army buddy arrived in Easton on Saturday night.
