### Ensign Cary Evans Goes To New Orleans

Ensign Cary G. Evans, USNR, Lehigh track captain in 1939, has reported for duty at the Naval Armed Guard Center in New Orleans, where

he is awaiting orders to take charge of the naval gun crew on a merchant vessel. He will be charged with the defense of the ship in case of attack. **NOV 2 1943**

Since going to active duty in the Naval Reserve, Ensign Evans has been under instruction at Cornell, Boston, and at the advanced gunnery school at Gulfport, Miss., where he trained enlisted men in handling naval ordnance.

Before entering the service last April, Ensign Evans was a supervisor in the production department of the Bethlehem Steel Company. His wife, Mrs. Elizabeth McCall Evans, lives at 464 North New Street, this city.
