## John R. Ellstrom Enters Navy as Lieutenant (j. g.)

John Roberts Ellstrom, son of Mrs. V. E. Ellstrom and the late Mr. Ellstrom, of Sellersville, R. D. 1, formerly of Bethlehem, has entered the United States Naval Reserve with the rank of lieuten-

ant, junior grade. He has been sent to the Naval Training Station at Cornell University for his boot training.

Lieut. Ellstrom is a graduate of Liberty High School and Lehigh University, class of 1933, where he was a member of Sigma Chi fraternity. He has been employed as sales engineer by the Quaker Chemical Corporation of Conshohacken.

He was married to Miss Arlene Shelly, of Vera Cruz, in September, 1939. They have one daughter, Eva Patricia. Mrs. Ellstrom will join her husband at Ithaca, N. Y., in about two weeks.

Lieut. Ellstrom's brother, Lieut. George Ellstrom, U. S. Army Air Corps, was the first airman killed in the attack on the Phillipines by the Japanese, Dec. 8, 1941. His father, Victor E. Ellstrom, for many years a structural sales engineer with the Bethlehem Steel Company, died May 22, after an illness of several years.
