BOWMAN FIELD, Louisville, Ky. —The War Department announced the promotion this week of 1st Lt. William R. Csellak, base ordnance officer, to the rank of captain.

Captain Csellak is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Csellak of 419 Webster Street, Bethlehem.

The Army called him to active duty on June 26, 1941. He was stationed at Stout Field, Indianapolis, Ind., for five months prior to his arrival at Bowman Field, July 15, 1943. He received his promotion to the rank of first lieutenant on Aug. 30, 1942.

The Captain was graduated in 1940 from Lehigh University in Bethlehem, Pa., with a B. S. degree in chemical engineering, and attended the Appleton, Wis., Institute of Paper Chemistry, for one year toward a Ph. D. degree. He served in part time Summer work

with the Bethlehem Steel Company Rolling Mills and the Bethlehem Boys Club. He is an ROTC graduate, and was a member of the Tau Beta Pi, national honorary engineering fraternity. The former Miss Melba Glee Keil, of Iowa, is his wife, and now resides at 1032 Bluegrass Avenue in Louisville, Ky.
