From Cousin Back 5  
From War Hospital 1945**

Mrs. Charles Kriebel, 302 Eighth Avenue, received a telephone call

from her cousin, First Sgt. Earl Stitzer, Fleetwood, informing her that he had been flown to New York from a hospital in England. In the service three years, Sgt. Stitzer saw action in Sicily, France and Germany, where he was wounded last October. Mrs. Kriebel received another telephone call last evening from Sgt. Stitzer, during which he stated he expected to be sent to another Army hospital in the States, before starting out on his expected furlough. His parents are Mr. and Mrs. Clarence Stitzer, Fleetwood.
