Corporal Edward Ackerman, who resided with his sister, Mrs. Harry Huseman, 603 Lechauweki Avenue, Fountain Hill, previously reported missing in action since January 16, is now reported killed in action in Belgium. Cpl. Ackerman was injured in the D-Day invasion and received the Purple Heart. After recuperating at a hospital in England he was sent back to the front. A former Bethlehem Steel Company employe, his parents live in Pittston, Pa. Three brothers are also in the service: Howard, somewhere in the Pacific; Elmer, somewhere in Belgium, and Herman, a bombardier in the U. S. Navy.
