Miss Lucy De Crosta, 538 Bradley Street, received a letter from her brother, Corporal Anthony C. DeCrosta, stating he had been liberated from a German prisoner of war camp and is recuperating in France. Cpl. De Crosta was reported missing in action December 20, 1944, by the War Department. April 11 his sister received a card stating he was being held a prisoner of the German government. Overseas for a year and a half, De Crosta was a member of the 28th Division, Quartermaster Corps. He entered the service March 26, four years ago.
