Charles W. Searfoss, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Searfoss, 816 Walton Street, has been advanced to the rank of Corporal, according to information received by his parents. A member of a field artillery unit, he is stationed "somewhere in Ireland."

He was inducted into the armed forces on May 29, 1943, and received his preliminary training at Fort Bragg, N. C. He was later transferred to Camp Meade, Md., from which point he left for overseas duty in December, 1943. Before his induction he was an employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.

He has two brothers in the combat forces, Private Carl Searfoss, stationed in New Guinea, and Private George Searfoss, "somewhere enroute to one of the theatres of war." Both were former employes of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
