J. A. Lozensky, son of Andrew J. Lozensky, of Bethlehem R. D. 4, has been promoted to Chief Yeoman on a vessel in the Mediterranean theater of war.

He enlisted as a private in the 11 Medical Regiment November 4, 1938, was transferred to the Field Artillery Band in 1939 and was sent overseas. He returned to the States in 1940 and was stationed at Camp Lee, Va., where he was discharged in the grade of Sergeant.

Lozensky again enlisted, this time in the U. S. Navy, February 10, 1942. He took his boot training at Norfolk, Va., and was transferred to active duty in the Mediterranean, where he has been for the past 12 months.

He attended Bethlehem and Allentown preparatory schools and Bethlehem High School.
