## Local Marine Loses Life On Okinawa

Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Bernath, 1227 East Fourth Street, were informed of the death of their son Pfc. Joseph Bernath, U. S. M. C., who was killed in action against the enemy on Okinawa.

Pfc. Bernath, whose wife, Louise, resides in Washington, D. C., enlisted in the Marine Corps two years ago. He trained at Rhode Island and Washington, D. C., before going overseas to the Pacific island. Bernath attended St. John Capistrano Parochial School and Broughal Junior High School. He was a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.

In addition to his wife and parents, he is survived by two brothers, William and Eugene, and two sisters, Anna and Margaret, all of Bethlehem.
