## Pfc. Del Grosso Wounded In German Action

A War Department telegram was received today by Mr. and Mrs. Dominic Del Grosso, of 812 East Fifth Street, informing them that their son, Pfc. John Del Grosso, was wounded in Germany March 17. The young man is now recuperating in an Army hospital in England.

Formerly employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company, Pfc. Del Grosso entered the armed service February 2, 1942. At the completion of training at Camp Wheeler, Ga.; Camp Blanding, Fla., and Indiantown Gap, he was sent overseas in August, 1942. Since that time he has engaged in action in Africa, Italy, Belgium, France and Germany.

A younger brother, Pfc. Michael Del Grosso, left for overseas duty 20 months ago. He is serving in the Philippines.
