**Memorial Service

Largely Attended**

Relatives and friends of Sgt. Paul H. Huhn of Shelly, who died in England in August from wounds received in France, attended Chestnut Hill Church last Sunday afternoon for a memorial service in his honor.

The chancel of the church was filled with flowers given in his memory. Rev. William Rupp was in charge of the service and preached the memorial sermon. Ruth Hausman, organist, and the choir assisted in the service.

Sgt. Huhn was the first member of the Chestnut Hill Church to make the supreme sacrifice in this war. He was buried in Cambridge, England.
