On January 1, Sgt. Wilson G. Sloyer was promoted to staff sergeant. He heard of his advancement after his return from a 14-day furlough spent here with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Wilson G. Sloyer, 1006 Cherokee Street. He has been in the service since January 19, 1943 and since that time proved his ability in technical training when he graduated from an Oklahoma college with top honors and distinction. His basic training was received at Miami Beach, Florida. On November 1 he was promoted to corporal, received his third stripe on December 1, and started the new year as staff sergeant. At present he is stationed with the 827th Bombardment Squadron in Harvard, Nebraska. He has one brother, Robert, in the service, who is studying radio at Truax Field, Madison, Wisconsin.
