REPORTED MISSING

Sergeant George A. Yanek, U. S. Marines, son of Mr. and Mrs. Felix Yanek, 2420 Taylor st., Youngstown, O., is missing in action, according to information received by his parents from the Navy Department. The information failed to state the "how and where."

During the early part of February of this year, he visited a large number of his relatives in Bethlehem, among whom were Mr. and Mrs. Enro Yanek, 526 Thomas st.

He was serving his second enlistment with the "Leathernecks", joining the forces while still in his teens. At the close of his first enlistment he worked for the Republic Steel Corporation and the Ravena Arsenal. When the United States declared war on Japan, he lost no time in returning to the armed forces. He saw action in both the eastern and western battle areas:
