Szep entered the Parks Air College, St. Louis, after graduating from Liberty High School in 1934. An outstanding student there, he was taken by the president of the Lockheed Corporation immediately after graduating in 1936, as an aeronautical engineer. A design engineer, his work consists chiefly of mapping out blueprints of the jet mechanism used in the plane.
