Pfc. Robert A. Ricci Is Jap Prisoner

Eighteen months ago Mrs. Rose Ricci, 824 East Fourth Street, received a letter from her son, Private First Class Robert A. Ricci, a mechanic in the U. S. Air Corps, informing her that he landed in the Phillipines.

That was before the Jap sneak on Pearl Harbor, and for one and one-half years she knew nothing as to his whereabouts.

Today, through the International Red Cross, she received a telegram, telling her that her son was a prisoner of the Japs, and is held at one of the camps in the Phillipines.

A former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, he enlisted in the armed forces in 1941, and reached the Phillipines only a short time before the Jap invasion.
