**Recruiting Office to be Set Up Here
for Special Service.**

A recruiting station for applicants of the Army Specialist Corps was established in the home of Bethlehem Post, No. 855, Veterans of Foreign Wars, by action taken at the meeting Monday evening. Stephen Polenchar, commander, was in charge.

Announcement will be made shortly as to what days the recruiting officer will be here. The main eligibility requirement, according to instructions received, is that the applicant have the educational qualifications as well as practical experience in the specialized position for which he applies. Physical requirements are only secondary to the primary qualifications, it was announced.

Successful applicants will be sent to various parts of the country to release specialists for service abroad, possibly, but they will be called only by notification of vacancies by the government. Persons between the ages of 18 and 55 are invited to apply.

The other program sponsored by the post which provides for the preparation of air cadets for official tests is progressing rapidly, it was reported. Numerous applicants have responded and the post is ready to start instruction.

Two new members were admitted. Letters from members in service, W. Hillegas, Camp Barkley, Tex., and Frank R. Guzzo, U. S. Navy, were read.
