Promoted On Duty

Josephine T. Grube, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harvey Grube who resides in Bath, has been promoted to Private First Class in the Women's Army Corps, according to a recent announcement by Col. C. S. Doney, Commanding Officer of the Harbor Defenses of the Columbia.

Before entering the Army Pfc. Grube was graduated from Bethlehem High School and was subsequently employed as a machine tool operator by the Bonney Forge and Tool Works at Allentown, Pennsylvania.

Pfc. Grube entered the Army in February, 1944. She took her basic training at Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia, and after completion of that training she studied a course in Motor Transport. In June, 1944, Pfc. Grube was transferred to Fort Stevens, Oregon, where she is now on duty as a dispatcher in the motor pool."
