Anthony V. Ursic, son of John Ursic, Sr., and the late Elizabeth Ursic, Miller Heights, was one of six commissioned men to receive his B. S. degree.

The only one in his group to receive immediate orders for ship duty, Ursic was given a brief leave and has since returned to the West Coast. Before he left, Ensign Ursic was given a party attended by 114 relatives and friends at the home of his sister, Mrs. Josephine Sakovics.

Ensign Ursic is a graduate of Liberty High school, where he was a member of the Glee Club and various school groups. He played with local orchestras and was organist at Sacred Heart Church in Miller Heights. Upon graduation from high school, he was employed by the Electrical Repair Shop of the Bethlehem Steel Company and attended Muhlenberg College. He enlisted in the V-12 program July 1, 1942, and for eight months trained at Muhlenberg College. He was then selected for Harvard as a midshipman in the Naval R. O. T. C.

The young Naval officer has three brothers in the service: S/Sgt. Frank, recently returned from 27 months overseas duty in the European Theater, to Indiantown Gap; Sgt. Henry, serving "somewhere in the Pacific," since September, 1943, with the U. S. Marine Corps, and Pvt. Albert, receiving Army Air Corps training at Lowry Field, Colo.
