Walter R. Rowe, husband of the former Arlene Correll, 27 East Garrison Street, informed his wife of his recent promotion to Private First Class and of his receiving the Good Conduct Medal in Germany.

Pfc. Rowe recently received a certificate from his commanding officer, honoring him for fighting with the 29th Infantry Division from D-Day to St. Lo. This unit was awarded two citations and its members 4,629 personal decorations since the outfit stormed the invasion beaches.

Two brothers were killed in action, Pfc. George in Italy and Pfc. Edward somewhere in Germany.
