Awarded Medal ^{1/1} 24 1944
For Good Conduct

NEW CALEDONIA—Tec. 5 James A. Rice, son of Mr. and Mrs. Allen G. Rice, 510 Twelfth Avenue, Bethlehem, Pa., has recently been awarded the Army's Good Conduct Medal for over a year of exemplary behavior, efficiency and fidelity as a soldier.

Prior to his induction in January of 1943, Corporal Rice, a graduate of Eckel's College of Embalming, was a funeral director in Bethlehem and also supervisor of the Heck Funeral Home in Easton, Pa.

At the present time Corporal Rice is the NCO in charge of the patients' rehabilitation program, 29th General Hospital. Rice has been with this unit for approximately a year and was shipped from the states with his outfit in November to the semi-tropical island of New Caledonia in the South Pacific.
