### Gets Good Conduct Medal In England

AN EIGHTH AAF BOMBER STATION, England—The Good Conduct Medal has been awarded to Corporal Russell H. Jacoby, Jr., 22, of 2544 Easton Avenue, Bethlehem, Pa. Cpl. Jacoby is an airplane mechanic, one of the men who keep the engines of the "Forts" in near perfect mechanical condition at this Eighth AAF Flying Fortress base in England.

Prior to entering the AAF in September, 1942, Cpl. Jacoby was graduated from Liberty High School in Bethlehem and later worked as a structural steel leader at the Bethlehem Steel Corp.

The Good Conduct Medal is conferred for "fidelity through faithful and exact performance of duty, conspicuous efficiency and exemplary behavior" during a year or more of service in the Army.
