Enroute here from Cape Girardeau, Mo., where he is commandant of a school of flying cadets, 1st Lieut. J. C. Miller Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Miller attended Blair Academy and Cornell University and entered the service last June, assigned to the flight training center for the Army Air Corps at Maxwell Field, Montgomery, Ala.
