## Sgt. Carlton Fink At Superfort Base In the Marianas

BOMBER COMMAND HEAD-  
QUARTERS, GUAM, (Delayed)—  
Sergeant Carlton W. Fink is one  
of the hundreds of enlisted men at  
a huge Superfortress base in the  
Marianas whose diligent efforts  
have made it possible for the giant  
B-29 bombers of Major General  
Curtis E. LeMay's Bomber Com-  
mand to strike regularly at the  
heart of Japan's war industry.

"The work of Sergeant Fink and  
his fellow soldiers is directly re-  
sponsible for the success of the  
B-29's in bombing Japan's war in-  
dustries," General O'Donnell said  
in congratulating them. "Without  
the spirit of teamwork which has  
been exhibited by every man, our  
pioneering job, which is only begin-  
ning, could not have been a suc-  
cess."
